Legal Requirements:

- Mandatory reporting (child/elder abuse)
- Imminent danger to self or others
- Public health emergencies

6. Data Retention and Storage

Therapeutic Records

- **Active clients:** Records maintained during treatment
- **Completed therapy:** 7 years minimum retention
- **Minor clients:** Until age 25 or 7 years, whichever is longer
- **Legal requirements:** Extended retention if legally required

Administrative Data

- **Account information:** Until account deletion
- **Payment records:** 7 years for tax purposes
- **Communication logs:** 3 years maximum
- **Technical logs:** 1 year for security purposes

Secure Disposal Process

When retention periods expire, we securely delete or destroy your information using industry-standard methods:

- **Digital Data:** Secure cryptographic deletion, multi-pass data overwriting, backup system purging
- **Physical Documents:** Professional shredding services, secure document destruction, certificate of destruction
- **Verification:** Deletion confirmation logs, audit trail maintenance, compliance verification
